2013/2014 Tree and Shrub Sale Order Form



There are a limited number of trees and shrubs available. Trees will be reserved with paid and completed order forms on the date in which they are received. Place your order early!

Minimum order of any one species is 25 trees. All orders must be in multiples of 25.

We are required to collect 5.5% sales tax on all trees sold. If you are tax exempt, please include your signed tax exemption form with your order.

Pick up will be mid to late spring at the Jefferson County Fair Grounds. Post cards will be sent out to notify customers of pick up dates and times. For more detailed description of trees or shrubs, visit our website or email kiml@jeffersoncountywi.gov

Fraser Fir 12"-16" \$30 ~ Has soft needles, an excellent fragrance and exceptional needle retention. Likes cool, moist well-drained soil. Full to partial sun. Height of 40'-60'.

White Pine 7"-15" \$30 ~ Large, open tree with long, soft, bluish-green needles. Grows best in moist, well drained, sandy loam soils. Full sun to partial shade. Height of 70'-100'.

Colorado Blue Spruce 12"-16" \$30 ~ Densely formed with stiff, silvery-blue to bluish-green needles. Thrives in dry well-drained soil and full sun. Grows well over 35' during it's long life span.

Norway Spruce 7"-15" \$30 ~ Stiff, dark green needles and draping branches. Does best in full to partial sun with a moist, well-drained, acidic soils but grows well in most conditions. Height 40'-60'.

White Spruce 7"-15" \$30 ~ Bluish-green needles, and short, dense branches. Does well in full sun and various soils. Height of 40'-60'.

Allegheny Serviceberry 12"-18" \$30 ~ Small, upright multi-stemmed tree can be grown as a small tree or large shrub. Soil and moisture type widely adaptable but prefers moist well drained loams. Full sun to partial shade. Grows to 25'.

Hazelnut 12"-18" \$30 ~ Small shrub often planted in clumps. Edible brown nuts. Grows best in moist, well-drained soils but will adapt to most types of soils. Full sun or deep shade. Height can reach 12'.

Red Oak 12"-18" \$30 ~ A wide, massive, shade tree. Long-lived, this acorn tree provides food and shelter for wildlife. Good for ornamental plantings, lumber and firewood. Prefers moist, rich, well drained soil and full to partial sun. Height of 80'-90'.

White Birch 9"-14" \$30 ~ Moderate to fast growth. Bark doesn't peel as readily as Native White Birch. Birch-borer resistant. Moist, well drained soil and full sun. Mature height up to 70'.
