WISCONSIN FARMLAND PRESERVATION TAX CREDIT **2015 ANNUAL CERTIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

READ AND FOLLOW CAREFULLY.

- Enclosed is your Annual Certification Form. In order to maintain compliance for the Wisconsin Farmland Preservation Tax Credit (FPP) you must fill out the form and return it along with the \$25 Certification fee to the Jefferson County Land & Water Conservation Department (LWCD) by April 15, 2015.
- **It is your responsibility to ensure a Crop Year 2015 590 checklist is on file with our office. Check with your crop consultant or renter to see if one has been turned in. If you have multiple renters each renter will need to have a checklist on file or submit both with your certification. *Farmer/landowner written plan are subject additional requirements detailed in the supplemental guide enclosed.***
- **Any omissions will result in your certification being returned to you.**
- **Please Note: You can file your Tax Return prior to turning in your Annual Certification.**
- If you have purchased or sold land or had a change in zoning, you will need to notify the Conservation Office to obtain a Compliance Certificate to send to the Department of Revenue documenting your eligible acres.
