

Bark River Paddle

Saturday, July 11, Burnt Village to Fort, 9:30 AM
Lunch at Café Carpe, around noon

Join the Friends of GHA on this lovely, family-friendly paddle down the Bark River, followed by lunch at Cafe Carpe in Fort Atkinson, 18 South Water St. West. Choose from specially-prepared fare, ranging \$6-10 per plate (please contact friendsofgha@gmail.com to place your order). The paddle is about 2-3 hours long, depending on water levels.

The launch site is Burnt Village Park (put in #48, County Hwy N) to Fort Atkinson Public Launch (take out #65, N. Water Street). See the free GHA Watertrails Map for put in/take out locations, which is available at glacialheritagearea.org, friendsofgha@gmail.com and 2Rivers Bicycle & Outdoor. ***Please be unloaded at Burnt Village Park and ready to shuttle vehicles at 9:15 AM so we can launch around 9:30 AM.***

Bring your binoculars to spot birds along the way - an owl, egrets and many warblers were seen on last year's paddle.
