


# Let's Build the Bike Trail!

## INTERURBAN RECREATION TRAIL



The Interurban Trail is a proposed, blacktop paved off-road multi-use trail that will support people bicycling, people walking, and non-motorized recreational purposes. It will offer cyclists the opportunity to ride safely from the northern end of the Glacial River Trail in Watertown east to the shores of Lake Michigan connecting along the way to trails such as the Lake Country Trail in Waukesha County and the Hank Aaron Trail in Milwaukee.

The existing We Energies right-of-way corridor will be utilized for the Interurban bike trail route.



## How Much Will it Cost?

**Segment 1:** City of Watertown to River Road (2.26 miles) = \$1.4m

**Segment 2:** River Road to Cty Hwy F (4.7 miles) = \$1.6m

**Segment 3:** Cty Hwy F to City of Oconomowoc (4 miles) = \$2.1m

**Total Project Cost: \$5.1m**



## What Will the Interurban Trail Do?

The Interurban Recreation Trail is a multi-use bike trail linking the City of Watertown to the City of Oconomowoc via the existing We Energies right-of-way corridor. The proposed route along the corridor is 10.96 miles, with the first 2.26 mile segment starting at the intersection of Humboldt Street and Munzel Drive in Watertown heading east to River Road.

This trail will connect with the current network of trails that begins west of the City of Oconomowoc to the lakefront in Milwaukee. This trail extends the network west to the City of Watertown and also provides connections to the Glacial Drumlin Trail, Glacial River Trail and Wild Goose State Trail.
