A 167-acre property situated at the headwaters of Lake Ripley's inlet stream, the Preserve's main hiking trail meanders through wetlands, restored prairie and deciduous woods. The gently rolling trail is under three miles long.

- Please wear a piece of orange blaze clothing (hat, vest), good hiking shoes and hiking poles if needed.
- Restrooms will be open at the Oakland Town Hall (N4450 Cty Rd A) twenty minutes prior to the hike and after the hike.
- In case of inclement weather, check Facebook (Glacial Heritage Area) for cancellation.

To get there: from Hwy 12 in Jefferson County, turn onto Cty Rd A (turn right from Fort Atkinson, turn left from Cambridge). Look for the Preserve sign near the parking area on the east side of the road.
