

**ORDINANCE NO. 96-14**

WHEREAS, parcel identification numbers are used by various County departments and the general public to locate land and related information, and

WHEREAS, requiring the mandatory use of parcel identification numbers on recorded documents will be helpful to the various County departments and the general public,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

1. The Register of Deeds shall not accept for recording any conveyance of any interest in real estate, as defined in Section 706.01(4) of the Wisconsin Statutes, which does not contain the parcel identification number.

2. A person recording a conveyance for a newly created parcel for which a parcel identification number has not been assigned shall obtain such number from the Jefferson County Land Information Office, or if such parcel is in the City of Watertown, from the City of Watertown Assessor.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1997.
