

County board debate slated next Tuesday

JEFFERSON — Area residents are invited to meet the eight candidates for four contested seats on the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors during a debate Tuesday, March 29, in Jefferson.

The event will take place in the Puerner Room of the Fort Community Credit Union, 100 N. Main St. It will start at 6 p.m. with refreshments and a meet-and-greet with candidates, followed by the debate at 6:30 p.m.

The candidates include: District 10 incumbent Lloyd Zastrow and challenger Mark Groose, District 20 incumbent Jim Mode and challenger Frankie Fuller, District 27 incumbent Glen Borland and challenger Robert Bennett, and District 30 incumbent Walt Christensen and challenger Gary Kutz.

District 10 includes Wards 1 and 3 in the Town of Concord, Wards 3 and 4 in the Town of Ixonia; District 20, Wards 1, 2 and 3 in the Town of Jefferson and Ward 4 in the Town of Oakland; District 27, Wards 3 and 4 in the City of Fort Atkinson; and District 30, Wards 4-6 in the Town of Koshkonong and Ward 1 in the Town of Sumner.

The debate's moderator will be WFAW news director Michael Clish and the event will be broadcast live on WFAW/WKCH. The forum podcast will be able to be accessed at the WFAW website at www.940WFAW.com.
